TRENCH TOWN ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, SOUTH FLORIDA GIVES BACK TO SCHOOL

Some members of the South Florida Chapter of the Trench Town Comprehensive Alumni Association made a presentation of needed items to the school on March 1, 2011 when they participated in the annual school prize-giving ceremony. A check for \$3,000 was given to support the school's sports development and the student breakfast programs. The monetary donation is a result of the second annual fundraiser held last November in Fort Lauderdale.

In addition, five sewing machines were donated to the School's Home Economics Department. A total of ten sewing machines have been targeted for the Department, the first five of which have been donated by members of the Association. President of the Alumni Association, the Reverend Dennis Grant led the delegation. He indicated that the machines will be purchased in Jamaica with donations from individual alumni members, in an effort to utilize the resources in Jamaica. He also noted that members of the alumni association have undertaken projects to help equip the Home Economics and the Mechanical Departments.

Rev. Grant also informed JIS News that a graduating science student from Trench Town Comprehensive was awarded a scholarship to pursue college studies. The scholarship totaling US\$500 is the first in a stream of generous donations from alumni member and Fort Lauderdale resident, Ms. Cecile Nulty, who has decided to begin an annual donation to the school's scholarship program. The scholarship presentation was made at the prize-giving ceremony on Tuesday, March 1, 2011. In an effort to assist in Jamaica's education development, Rev. Grant noted that his association was making a concerted effort to contribute to the development of schools in inner-city communities. He urged nationals in the Diaspora to continue their commitment to their alma maters.

Jamaica's Consul General Sandra Grant Griffiths commended members of the alumni associations for their philanthropic efforts particularly to schools. More than 40 alumni associations representing schools in Jamaica form the Coalition of Jamaican Alumni Associations in South Florida. The Trench Town High School Alumni Association began its South Florida chapter in November 2009 and now boasts a growing membership of more than 100 persons.

Jamaican Student Posts Perfect SAT Score

SIXTEEN-year-old student Damien Chang has created local history by becoming the first Jamaican student to earn a perfect 2,400 score in the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) for college admittance in the United States. News of Chang's achievement was posted on the website of his school, Woodberry Forest, yesterday. However, the teen received the news on February 10, the Observer was told.

"Upon learning the news from the College Board, the soft-spoken fifth former was so eager to tell his parents that he ran outside in the snow without bothering to grab shoes or a jacket so he could get reception and make a cell-phone call," the story posted on the Woodberry Forest School website said. It added that Chang "has accomplished something that fewer than 400 of the 1.5 million students who took the SAT last year managed to do".

"My parents were really, really proud of me," the excited teen said of his first SAT experience, explaining that he studied by taking six practice tests from the College Board's official test prep book. "I was scoring in the 2,300 range on the practice tests, so I thought I would do well, but I never thought I would have a perfect score," he said. Chang's achievement breaks the 15-year record held by Romero Heyman of Manchester High School who scored 1,570 of the maximum 1,600 when he sat the test.

Yesterday, educator Dennis Minott, founder of AQuest which helped to train Heyman, said the former Manchester student's score would be equivalent to 2,360 in today's test which has undergone some modifications.

Chang, who attended Hillel Prep and High schools in Jamaica, and was a member of the Observer TEENage club last summer, plans to study engineering in college. He said he chose Woodberry after learning about it through an independent school fair in Kingston. "It was just the right size for me, and I thought the structure of study hall and Saturday classes would help me do better in school," he explained, adding that his grades have indeed improved.

Building off the success of its inaugural Benefit Gala last year, and with such a strong Caribbean community in Canada, UWI is striving to develop a successful event that will continue to strengthen the relationship between Canada and the Caribbean for years to come. The 2010 Benefit Gala was sold out with 460 attendees and approximately \$230,000 was raised, resulting in 17 scholarships being awarded to students in need.
